Purpose of project

This project will include pavement upgrades, as well as a number of safety improvements. For the railroad crossing, the improvements will include the reconstruction of four railroad crossings and replacement of the aging signal/gate system. For the roadway, medians will be installed to prevent drivers from going around lowered gate arms. Sidewalks, curb ramps and signals will also be improved to meet Americans with Disabilities Act standards. For pedestrians, the side walk on east side of Humboldt Avenue will be converted into a shared path. This will be between Grand Rounds and Shingle Creek trails.

At the open house

There will be no formal presentation, but design staff will be on hand to provide a project overview - including anticipated project layout and tentative construction timeline. This is an opportunity to ask any questions you might have about the preliminary designs.
