- Demonstrate commitment to the leadership team and the overall vision & goals of the committee.
- Possess good communication skills that include: interpersonal, listening & speaking skills.
- Always act as a positive public relations person that represents the Shingle Creek Neighborhood Association.
- Show the ability to distinguish between major and minor issues and focus on major issues.
- Abide by all local, state & federal laws
- Abide by the By-Laws of the Shingle Creek Neighborhood Association & these Conduct Expectations.
