

Humboldt Avenue improvements

County Road 57 in Minneapolis

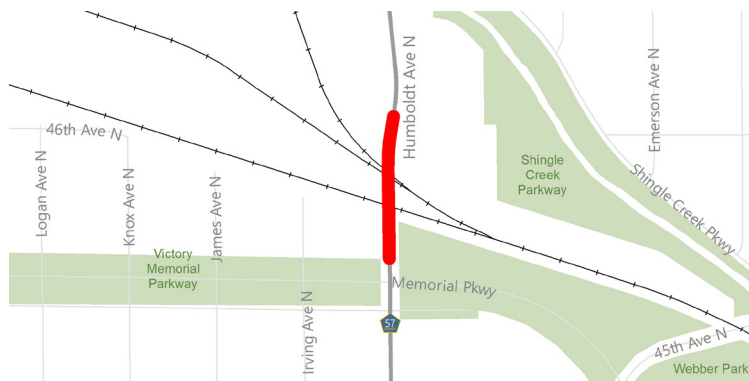
Hennepin County is working with partner agencies to improve rail crossing and roadway safety at this busy location north of Memorial Drive, where trains intersect with people using Humboldt Avenue for driving, biking and walking.

Improvements at rail crossing

Rail improvements include the reconstruction of four railroad crossings and replacement of the aging signal/gate system. This new signal system will be more efficient and should reduce the number of false alarm triggers of the gates. Medians will be installed to prevent drivers from going around lowered gate arms. This work is being funded in part by federal funds granted to address this priority location.

Improvements on Humboldt Avenue

Sidewalks and curb ramps will also be improved to meet Americans with Disabilities Act standards. On the east side of Humboldt Avenue, convert sidewalk into a shared path. This will be between Grand Rounds and Shingle Creek trails.



Project timeline

The project is currently in preliminary design. Construction is scheduled to take place in the summer of 2018.
