## Creating a Community Center in Shingle Creek? What will it take?

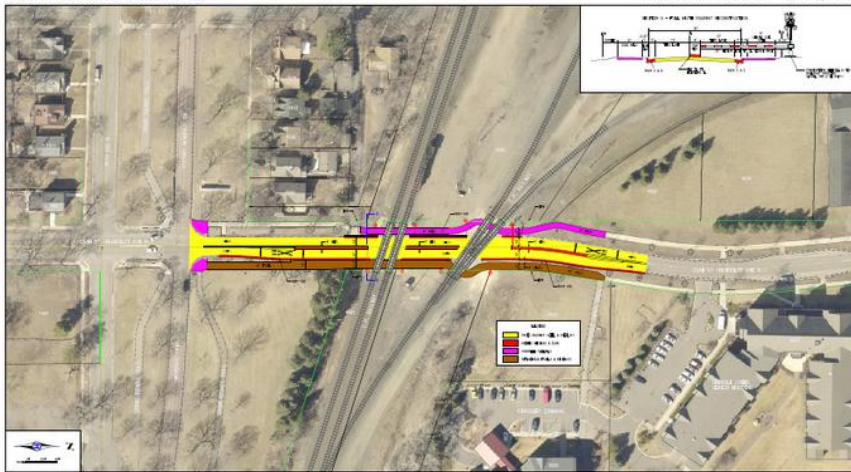
Please join us on Tuesday January 9th at 6:30pm at our SCNA Neighborhood/Board meeting at Creekview Park where we'll be asking MPRB Commissioner Kale Severson, and MPRB Northside Park Service Area Director this question!

SCNA heard from Shingle Creek residents that creating a community center is one of their top priorities and earmarked a significant amount of funds toward this effort. Two of our SCNA Board members have been participating on the Recquest efforts by the MPRB which has been studying the programming offered by MPRB both citywide and on the Northside. The other reflective effort going on by MPRB right now is the Northside Service Area Master planning which is looking at all of the outside amenities and park areas and engaging the community about what they feel are areas of strengths and challenges and where improvements could possibly be made.
